

NAME

`curl_easy_strerror` - return string describing error code

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
const char *curl_easy_strerror(CURLcode errnum);
```

DESCRIPTION

The `curl_easy_strerror(3)` function returns a string describing the CURLcode error code passed in the argument *errnum*.

Typically applications also appreciate `CURLOPT_ERRORBUFFER(3)` for more specific error descriptions generated at run-time.

AVAILABILITY

This function was added in libcurl 7.12.0

RETURN VALUE

A pointer to a zero terminated string.
