## NAME

`CURLOPT_CHUNK_LENGTH_PENALTY_SIZE` – chunk length threshold for pipelining

## SYNOPSIS

## DESCRIPTION

Pass a long with a **size** in bytes. If a pipelined connection is currently processing a chunked (Transfer-encoding: chunked) request with a current chunk length larger than `CURLOPT_CHUNK_LENGTH_PENALTY_SIZE(3)`, that pipeline will not be considered for additional requests, even if it is shorter than `CURLOPT_MAX_PIPELINE_LENGTH(3)`.

## DEFAULT

The default value is 0, which means that the penalization is inactive.
