## NAME

CURLOPT\_RTSP\_SESSION\_ID – set RTSP session ID

## SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_RTSP_SESSION_ID, char *id);
```

## DESCRIPTION

Pass a char \* as a parameter to set the value of the current RTSP Session ID for the handle. Useful for resuming an in-progress session. Once this value is set to any non-NULL value, libcurl will return *CURLE\_RTSP\_SESSION\_ERROR* if ID received from the server does not match. If unset (or set to NULL), libcurl will automatically set the ID the first time the server sets it in a response.
