## NAME

CURLOPT\_HTTP\_CONTENT\_DECODING – enable/disable HTTP content decoding

## SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_HTTP_CONTENT_DECODING,  
                           long enabled);
```

## DESCRIPTION

Pass a long to tell libcurl how to act on content decoding. If set to zero, content decoding will be disabled. If set to 1 it is enabled. Libcurl has no default content decoding but requires you to use *CURLOPT\_ACCEPT\_ENCODING(3)* for that.
